
Prevalence (%) of Lifetime, Past Year & Current Use (2023)









Prevalence by Gender





Prevalence (%) of Lifetime Use (Less Popular Substances)



Prevalence (%) of Lifetime Use – (Less Popular Substances)
















Alcohol Use Disorder Identification Test (AUDIT) Zones (Risk Level) by Gender






Risk Perception by Substance (Using Often)




Ease of Access by Gender and Drug




Treatment for Substance Use

Approximately 3% (2.8%) felt a need for help to reduce or stop using alcohol or drugs, (Males - 4.10%, females 1.5%) – Estimated 60,000 persons


Next Steps
